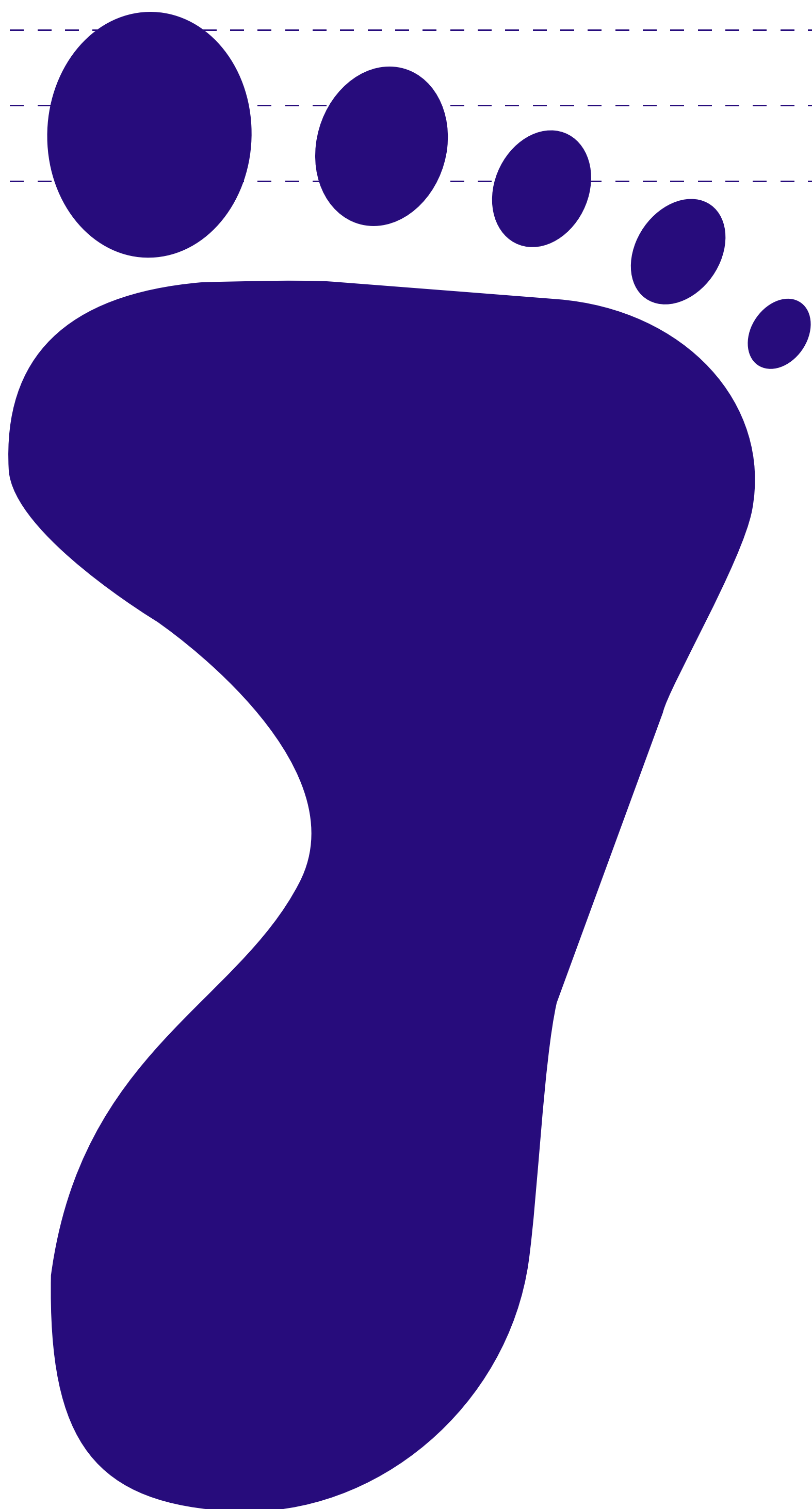

How to measure

1. Ensure your printer is set to 100%. When printed, the green line on the left should measure 235mm or 9.25".
2. Fold at the base line and place the sheet against a wall. Ask the child to stand on the page with their heel against the wall.
3. Take measurement from the longest toe and record this.
4. Then repeat with the other foot.
5. Use the measurement of the longest foot when selecting your shoe size.

Fitting

- Once you have both shoes on, test as follows.
1. Ask your child to stand straight. There should be about a thumbs width between the end of the longest toe and the front of the shoe.
 2. With your finger, check there is no gap between their heel and the shoe.
 3. Watch the child walk and ensure there is no slipping off at the back of the heel.
 4. Remember to check your child from time to time to see if they have grown.
