
Shoe Sizing Guide





How to measure

- 1. Ensure your printer is set to 100%. When printed, the green line on the left should measure 235mm or 9.25".
- 2. Fold at the base line and place the sheet against a wall. Ask the child to stand on the page with their heel against the wall.
- 3. Take measurement from the longest toe and record this.
- 4. Then repeat with the other foot.
- 5. Use the measurement of the longest foot when selecting your shoe size.

Fitting

Once you have both shoes on, test as follows.

- 1. Ask your child to stand straight. There should be about a thumbs width between the end of the longest toe and the front of the shoe.
- 2. With your finger, check there is no gap between their heel and the shoe.
- 3. Watch the child walk and ensure there is no slipping off at the back of the heel.
- 4. Remember to check your child from time to time to see if they have grown.
